All other posters are property of the APRCWA and will not be returned to the student/school.

RULES

- ✓ Artwork must reflect our theme, Rural Crime Watch, Crime Prevention and/or Report A Poacher. Artwork is to be done in a **landscape format** (horizontal 11" x 8.5").
- ✓ Student's name, student's grade, school name, home address, and telephone numbers are to be printed on the **back** of the artwork in **pencil**. **Please include parental consent forms TAPED (not stapled) to the back of the poster.**
- ✓ Please add the name of your Rural Crime Watch Association to the back as well before sending in the 1st Place posters.
- ✓ The Alberta Provincial Rural Crime Watch Poster Contest 2010 Committee must receive winning posters by **November 25, 2011.**

* ***Winners names (and possibly photo) are published in The Bulletin, which is also posted on-line. Parents MUST give permission for children's names/photo to be published. RELEASE FORM must accompany art work.***
