# Introduction

The Farmers' Advocate Office (FAO) continues to support the efforts of the Provincial Rural Crime Watch Program, the provincial board, and the many local associations.

This award is one method to promote and reward local associations for their hard work.

# The Award

The award application should reflect excellence in one or more of the three categories:

1. Consumer protection for rural Albertans
2. Rural opportunities for rural Albertans
3. Rural Albertans have fair process

The FAO is not looking for projects that establish base services in a Rural Crime Watch Association membership area. The FAO would recognize and reward associations that take on issues and projects which address one or more of the above categories as outcomes to the project.

The award is a \$300 grant and plaque which will be released at the annual meeting of the provincial association. The FAO reserves the right to award the grant to the provincial association or a deserving local crime watch program in the event no applications are received.

Deadline for applications will be December 31 of each year.

# Application

The application will be in the format appropriate to the local association. The written application will answer the following questions:

What was the issue in the community?

What action did you as an association take to address this issue?

What impact did you have on the issue?

The application will have the contact information of the association and be signed by two signing officers.
