**Fish and Wildlife Officer:** Phone the government toll free line (310-0000) and ask to be connected to your local fish and wildlife office. Bring in

a speaker on hunting regulations and the regulations pertaining to land ownership. There is a great deal to learn about the wildlife act.

**Wise Owl Program: Phone: 1-877-877-4323**

This program is administered through your Alberta Provincial Crime Watch Association. Bring in a speaker on fraud prevention of all kinds. This program will cover fraud as it pertains to seniors and others. They will also likely talk on seniors abuse and bullying.

**Alberta Agriculture:** Phone: 310-0000 (the provincial government toll free number) and ask to speak to Laurel Aitken the provincial farm safety coordinator. She can put you in touch with an individual that can speak at your meeting on farm safety. Kitscoty RCW has had a speaker come out of the Vermilion Ag Office and she was very good.

**County Enforcement Officer:** Contact your local county office to see if they have a “County Mountie” employed in your area. These individuals are often employed to look after county or municipal roads in the area. They are often great speakers and can generate a large amount of interest in attending a crime watch meeting.
